

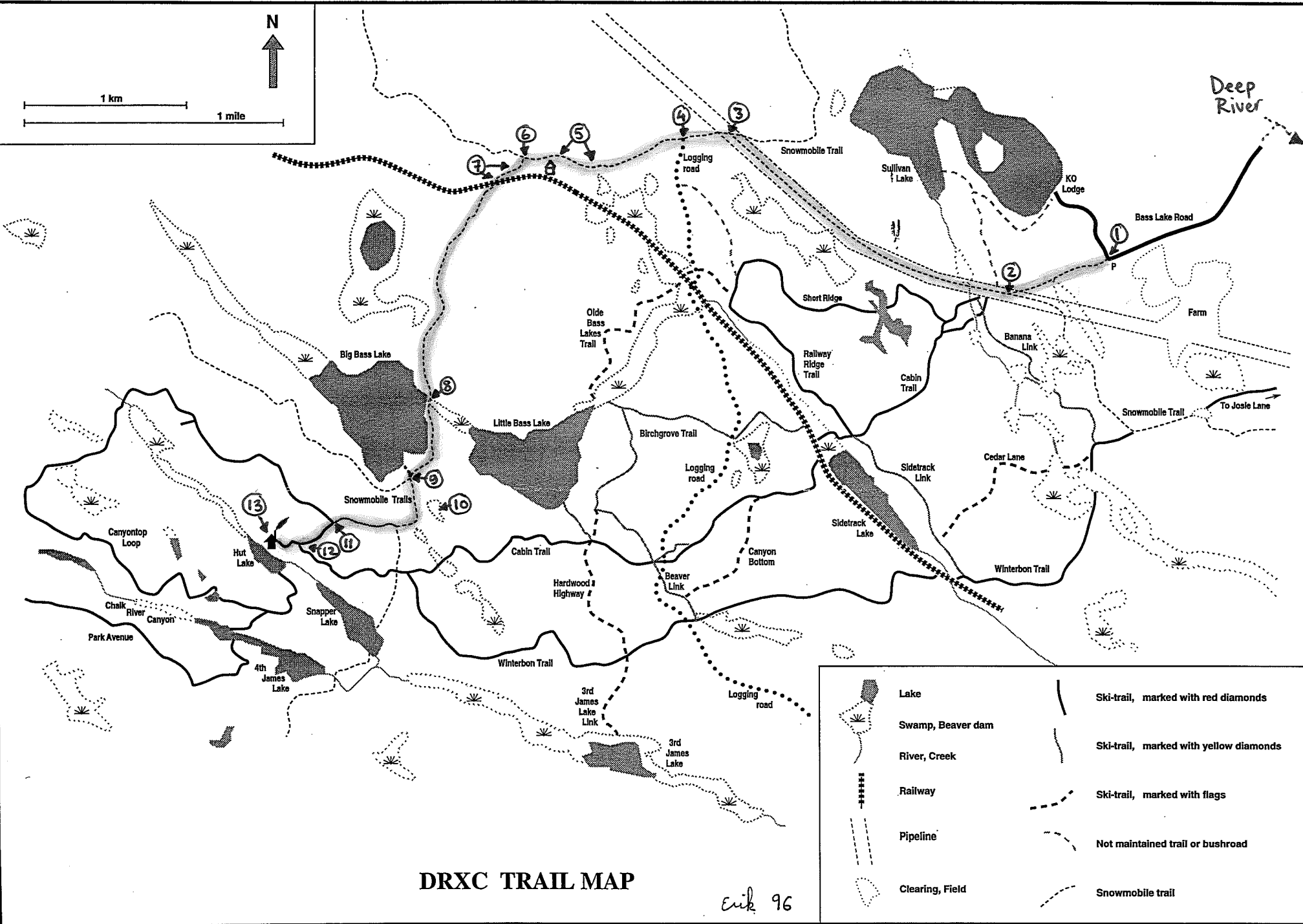

## Hike to DRXC ski cabin along snowmobile trail

Distance: ~7.5 km (one way)  
Hiking time: 2 hrs fast, 3 hrs leisurely (one way)  
Terrain: gently rolling hills, some wet spots  
Contact: Erik Hagberg (613-584-4636) for more info or to get key for cabin

### Directions To Cabin (see attached map)

1. Park car on Bass Lake Road (10 min west of Deep River) at 90 degree bend in road. Continue STRAIGHT on foot. (Road to right goes to K/O Lodge.)
2. Veer RIGHT to follow sandy road along pipeline. (Make note of this junction for the way back.)
3. Turn LEFT at junction with snowmobile trail (blue OFSA sign).
4. This is now also a logging road. After ~300m the logging road splits from the snowmobile trail; when road veers left, look for blue “Rolphton / Deep River” sign. At that point, do not continue on road to left – veer RIGHT on snowmobile trail.
5. Go over a few small creeks; go past cabin on left.
6. Not far past cabin, turn LEFT at junction onto a smaller trail. Main snowmobile trail continues by winding up a steep hill with a SLOW sign at base - do not go up hill.
7. Just past junction, there’s a large puddle of water. Cross railway tracks soon after.
8. Take off shoes, roll up pants, and enjoy wading across narrowing between Big Bass and Little Bass lakes.
9. As you’re leaving the lake area, be on the alert for a not-very-distinct 4-way junction; turn LEFT at junction. Do not go right (back to lake); do not go straight (old trail to nowhere.)
10. You’ll know you’re on correct trail with eventually a pond on the left (barely visible through trees), and a cluster of fallen trees that you need to bypass on the left.
11. At fork in trail, turn LEFT. Both trails are marked with red diamonds and are part of Canyontop Loop, but left will get you to cabin much quicker !
12. Go down ridge and turn RIGHT at junction (blank wooden sign on tree). You’ll see a rocky ledge on the right.
13. Ten more minutes– you’ve made it to the ski cabin !
