Bass Lake Trails Volunteer Drive

It seems like many DRXC members are unaware of the Bass Lake backcountry ski/snowshoe trails and the associated ski cabin that are maintained by the club. To help rectify this situation we are planning to hold an open house as part of the annual three-day trail clearing trip. We wish to welcome anyone who is interested in learning more to join us walking the trails and visiting the cabin.

The tentative dates for the trail clearing trip are October 17-19. Most experienced trail clearers will walk into the cabin on Friday, October 17th, stay two nights, and walk out on Sunday, Oct. 19th. On Saturday the 18th, some will clear the more remote Canyontop loop and others will do chores around the cabin. On the Saturday, Karen Colins has offered to drive passengers and supplies to a location close to the cabin. People are welcome to participate in the open house in many ways, such as: driving in and/or out with Karen, walking with the trail clearers, staying overnight at the cabin (or not), exploring some of the trails, or helping with trail clearing, cabin cleaning or firewood collection.
